

NEW! Impression Dies - Sterling Silver Hexagonal Zodiac Charms

Using master hubs from the early 1900's, make Zodiac charms using early 20th century methodology and craftsmanship combined with the modern technology of the hydraulic press. Although recommended to have jewelry making experience, these 7/16" x 7/16" baubles can be completed to wear as a pendant or hang on a charm bracelet. If you can solder silver, these charms can be used for earrings, cufflinks, ring toppers, accents, or appliqué. Sterling silver supplied for two (2) charms (including jump rings), but you can bring your own scrap sterling, Argentium, or fine silver to press additional charms. Bring needle files if you have them. Experienced students with proper tools can complete more advanced applications of these impressions in class.



A branch of the largest Chinese school system in the United States. The school teaches the Pin-Yin system and simplified characters to students ages 3 through high school. In addition to NCC, the Lehigh Valley HuaXia Chinese School receives strong support for its operations from Air Products.

Classes meet Sun, 1/11-5/3, 2-4 PM. Spring Festival Gala 2/15. No Class on 1/25 if NCC graduation is canceled on 1/24 & snow date 1/25 is needed for graduation. No class 2/15 and 4/5. 


