NCC's Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) and Emergency Medical Responder (EMR) programs prepare you to respond in critical moments with hands-on training, simulation labs, and field experience.

Emergency Medical Technician (EMT)

- **Level:** Intermediate EMS training (~200 hours)
- **Focus:** Airway management, BLS/CPR, trauma & medical emergencies, patient transport, EMS operations
- **Highlights:** High NREMT pass rate, veteran instructors, advanced simulation labs
- **Credits:** May count toward NCC's Emergency Services Administration AAS
- **Certification:** Eligible for PA/NREMT EMT exams

Emergency Medical Responder (EMR)

- **Level:** Entry-level EMS training (~90 hours)
- **Focus:** CPR, patient assessment, trauma & medical emergencies, special populations, EMS operations
- **Certification:** Eligible for PA/NREMT EMR exams

Eligibility & Funding

- Must be 16 or older.
- Proof of health insurance, clearances (PA PATCH, FBI, Child Abuse), and FEMA/HazMat courses required.
- Uniform and professional dress code apply.
- Scholarships and local funding assistance may be available.
